

- *MKUPwDA/PWD Office* – on the right, Students Centre entrance




Mount Kenya University Persons with Disabilities Association (MKUPwDA)





Key Responsibilities

ACHIEVEMENTS

Academic

- *Alumni:* Over 50 with Certificate, Diploma and Bachelors. Some started with certificate and advanced to bachelors.
- *Enrollment:* currently, three students in masters programmes; 1 deaf, 1 blind and 1 with physical impairment

- Participated in 2024 and 2025 Kenya University Sports Federation (KUSF). Won a trophy in goalball and dart and several medals in athletics
- Hosted Kenya Sports for Visually Impaired (KESSAVI) goalball tournaments in March 2025
